quality to allow for direct reuse. The recommendations provided by the task group will be forwarded to the WE-Stand Technical Committee for consideration in the development of the 2023 edition of the WE-Stand.

- B. Review the slide deck for "Water Reuse in Arizona and Potential Impacts on Premise Plumbing," by Peter Fox
 The Chair, Markus Lenger, reviewed the slide deck and answered questions from Task Group members. From this discussion, the Task Group determined the following
 - information is to be included in the recommendations:
 - Reliable sterilization
 - Performance requirements (parameters) for specific stages of the process system
 - Residential system diagrams (single family and small communities)
 - System schematics (simple and complex treatment systems)
 - Diagram trees for treatment methods
 - Automatic operation, maintenance, reporting, and shut-off for private systems

The Task Group agreed to the following action items:

- <u>Markus Lenger</u> is to create a flow diagram for treatment systems. Taylor Duran will format the information to comply with IAPMO's Manual of Style.
- <u>Tracy Strahl</u> is to research and determine size limitations for DPR applications.
- <u>Taylor Duran</u> is to assist with drafting a definition for "direct potable water reuse" and locate current sections of the WE-Stand pertaining to disinfection and treatment systems.
