 - General information with backstops for indoor plumbing and appliances;
 - Limited applicability to single-family dwellings;
 - A list of available efficiency rating systems; and
 - A national efficiency score/rating for each listed system.

- <u>Mike Collignon</u> is to generate a preliminary draft that includes general information and prerequisites/backstops.
- <u>Taylor Duran</u> is to review the preliminary draft and ensure compliance with IAPMO's Manual of Style.
- <u>All members</u> are to research and determine if nationally applicable ratings are possible.
