Question 1: In accordance with Section 313.7 which states, "Piping penetrations of fireresistance-rated walls, partitions, floors, floor/ceiling assemblies, roof/ceiling assemblies, or shaft enclosures shall be protected in accordance with the requirements of the Building Code, applicable standards referenced in Table 14-1 and Chapter 15, "Firestop Protection" would this section require the use of firestop installers with a minimum of 4 years of documented practical experience in the installation of piping systems?

Answer: NO

Question 2. Does the use of "shall" in Section 313.7 create a mandatory requirement in the 2009 UPC for ASME A112.20.2 as referenced in Table 14-1?

Answer: NO
