UMC TIA 009-18 revises text in the 2018 edition of the *UMC*, Section 1109.2 (Joints), Section 1109.7 (Pipe Enclosure), and Table 1701.1 (Referenced Standards) regarding press-connect joints for refrigeration piping. The comment form is located at:
